We left the rest alone, like the variable low pass filter (which can be bypassed for full-range amplification) and the phase switch, as well as keeping the 255R's high-current output abilities and flexible IO connectivity. So, stack'em, pack'em and rack'em to build a cost-effective, reliable and very powerful amplification system (perfect for powering Stealth's LR4 premium invisible speakers and Stealth's B30 totally invisible subwoofers).

Sporting 350 watts of analog driven, high-current power at 4-ohms, and a variable low-pass filter, the 255R has a filter bypass switch to allow high-current full-range operation. Balanced XLR, unbalanced RCA and speaker-level inputs - all with matching pass-through output connectors - making integration into any system a breeze.
